7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR
9 THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN
10 SERVICES, MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY
11 THE FIRE DEPARTMENT DURING 2024, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
15 Ohio, that:

16
17 Section 1. The Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of safety and turnout gear by the Fire Department during
19 2024.

20
21 Section 2. The Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
22 contracts, without competitive bidding, with Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. in amount not to
23 exceed \$125,000 for vehicle and equipment maintenance during 2024.

25 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from Capital
26 Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay and General Fund, Fire Department, line item Other
27 Operations.

29 Section 4. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
31 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
34 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that
35 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
36 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
37 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

39 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
40 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
41 and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
42 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
43 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by
44 law.
