7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
8 GRANT CARRYOVER FUNDS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024, AND
9 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is the recipient of Community Development Block Grant
12 ("CDBG") funds through the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

13
14 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has available CDBG carryover funds, in the amount of \$828,764;
15 and

16
17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover funds from calendar year 2023 to fund
18 calendar year 2024 program operations; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that the
21 aforementioned appropriations in the amount of \$828,764 are necessary and in the best interest of the City
22 of Cuyahoga Falls.

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit,
25 State of Ohio, that:

27 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the CDBG Fund,
28 line item, Other Operations, by \$828,764 and make payment from the same.

29
30 Section 2. Any ordinance or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith
31 are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
32 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33
34 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
35 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations
36 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to
37 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the
38 Codified Ordinances.

40 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary of the preservation
41 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the
42 inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or
43 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
44 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
