6 ORDINANCE NO. 29 - 2024

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF FURNITURE FOR  
11 THE NEW ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT BUILDING AND DECLARING  
12 AN EMERGENCY.  
13

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State  
15 of Ohio, that:

16  
17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
18 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of furniture for the new electric department  
19 building. The prices have been obtained using State Contract.  
20

21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same from  
22 the Electric Fund line-item Capital Outlay.  
23

24 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
25 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
26 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
27 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
28

29 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and concerning  
30 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council,  
31 and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal  
32 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the  
33 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
34

35 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
36 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
37 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of  
38 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately  
39 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the  
40 earliest period allowed by law.
