9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
10 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
11 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE 6" AND
12 8" WATER MAINS ON OAKWOOD DRIVE, FROM MONROE
13 AVENUE TO GRAHAM ROAD, WITH AN 8" WATER MAIN, AND
14 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
18 of Summit and State of Ohio:
19

20 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
21 contracts, according to law, for the replacement of the 6" and 8" water mains on Oakwood Drive,
22 from Monroe Avenue to Graham Road, with an 8" water main.
23

24 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same from
25 the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
26

27 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
28 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
29 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
30 confirmed.
31

32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
33 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
34 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
35 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the
36 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
37

38 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
39 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
40 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
41 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately
42 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
43 earliest period allowed by law.
