7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
9 WITH THE CITY OF AKRON, OHIO TO SHARE THE COST OF
10 ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK ON
11 WEST PORTAGE TRAIL, FROM NORTH PORTAGE PATH TO
12 WATERFORD COURT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
13

14 WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a cooperation agreement to share the cost of sidewalk
15 on West Portage Trail, from North Portage Path to Waterford Court, between the City of
16 Cuyahoga Falls and the City of Akron.
17

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
19 of Summit and State of Ohio:

21 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a cooperative
22 agreement with the City of Akron to share the cost of engineering and construction for new
23 sidewalk on West Portage Trail, from North Portage Path to Waterford Court.

25 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same
26 from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
27

28 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
30 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby
31 ratified and confirmed.

33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
34 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council,
35 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such
36 formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements,
37 to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
38

39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
40 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
41 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
42 two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
43 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be
44 in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


