A-56 Presented by the Administration CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 49 -2024

> AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE 2024-2028 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND CONSOLIDATED PLAN DOCUMENT, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, as a prerequisite to receiving the 2024-2028 Program Year Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") allocations, the City is required to submit a Consolidated Plan to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"); and

WHEREAS, the City's Community Development Department has prepared the Consolidated Plan for Program Year 2024-2028 as required by HUD.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The CDBG 2024-2028 Consolidated Plan Document is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Mayor, Director of Community Development, Director of Finance, Director of Law, and any other public official, individually or collectively, as may be appropriate, are authorized to prepare and execute such other documents together with such modifications and revision as shall be in furtherance of the 2024-2028 CDBG Consolidated Plant Document.

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
