AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 181.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Section 181.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls is hereby amended to read in full as follows (new text underlined; deleted text in strikethrough):

181.04 Award and Execution of Contracts

With respect to the award of any competitively bid contract, the award and execution of the contract shall be made within sixty days after the date on which the bids are opened unless otherwise provided in the bid specifications or unless the time for awarding and executing the contract is extended by mutual consent of the City and the bidder whose bid the City accepts and with whom the City subsequently awards and executes a contract. The contractor, upon request, is entitled to a notice to proceed with the work by the City upon execution of the contract. No contract to which this section applies shall be entered into if the price of the contract, or if the project involves multiple contracts where the total price of all contracts for the project is in excess of ten twenty percent above the engineer's estimate thereof. No contract shall be entered into until the industrial commission has certified that the person so awarded the contract has complied with Ohio R.C. 4123.01 to 4123.94, until, if the bidder so awarded the contract is a person nonresident of this state, such person has filed with the secretary of state a power of attorney designating the secretary of state as its agent for the purpose of accepting service of summons in any action, until the contractor has provided the necessary Drug Free Workplace and E.E.O. certifications, until the contract and bond, if any, are submitted to the Law Director and his approval as to form certified thereon, and until the Director of Finance has certified the appropriation of funds therefore.

Section 2. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE 2024-2028 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CONSOLIDATED PLAN DOCUMENT, AND

WHEREAS, as a prerequisite to receiving the 2024-2028 Program Year Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") allocations, the City is required to submit a Consolidated Plan to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"); and

WHEREAS, the City's Community Development Department has prepared the Consolidated Plan for Program Year 2024-2028 as required by HUD.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The CDBG 2024-2028 Consolidated Plan Document is hereby approved.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Mayor, Director of Community Development, Director of Finance, Director of Law, and any other public official, individually or collectively, as may be appropriate, are authorized to prepare and execute such other documents together with such modifications and revision as shall be in furtherance of the 2024-2028 CDBG Consolidated Plant Document.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT THE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, as a prerequisite to receive the 2024 Program Year Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") allocation, the City is required to submit an Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), that outlines the ways in which it plans to utilize its CDBG allocation for Program Year 1; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates receiving an approximate allocation of \$683,682 in CDBG funding for Program Year 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Development has prepared the Annual Action Plan for Program Year 2024 as required by HUD.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and submit the Annual Action Plan for Program Year 2024 to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Community Development Block Grant Program and the Community Development Department is authorized to carry out the programs contained within this document.

 <u>Section 2.</u> The Mayor, Director of Finance, Director of Community Development, Director of Law, and any other public officials, individually or collectively as may be appropriate, are authorized to prepare and execute such other documents, including contracts, and do all other things as necessary or incidental to carrying out the intent and/or requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
