8 A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE
9 SUMMIT COUNTY 9-1-1 PLAN AND DECLARING AN
10 EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 128.06 establishes that every county shall
13 maintain a county 9-1-1 Program Review Committee and that committee shall maintain
14 and approve a plan for implementing and operating the county 9-1-1 system (the "Plan");
15 and

16
17 WHEREAS, the Plan identifies each of the Public Safety Answering Points ("PSAPs") in
18 the County, indicates how they operate, the expense of operation, and establishes
19 processes for expending funds that the County receives from the State of Ohio 9-1-1
20 Government Assistance Fund; and

21
22 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 128.08 requires that the final plan shall be
23 adopted by the legislative authorities of municipal corporations and townships that
24 contain at least sixty percent of the county's population; and

25
26 WHEREAS, the Plan was updated in coordination with representatives from each PSAP
27 located in Summit County; and

29 WHEREAS, the updated Plan was subsequently approved by the Summit County 9-1-
30 1 Program Review Committee on March 27, 2024; and

32 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent
33 information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to
34 approve and adopt the aforementioned 9-1-1 Plan.

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
37 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

39 Section 1. The Council and Administration hereby approve and adopt the Summit
40 County 9-1-1 plan.

42 Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
43 concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open
44 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
45 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in
46 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

47
48 Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
49 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
50 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative
51 vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and
52 be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall
53 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


