RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING SUMMIT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has established rules and regulations under the United States Code of Federal Regulation, Title 44, Section 201.6, as authorized by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, requiring local governments to have a hazard mitigation plan approved pursuant to the aforementioned section in order to receive Hazard Mitigation Grant Program grants; and

WHEREAS, the Plan provides a guide for decision makers to help reduce risks from natural hazards and serves as a basis for the State of Ohio to provide technical and funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Agency (SCEMA) is responsible for updating the Plan every five years, and has updated the same; and

WHEREAS, the Plan was updated in coordination with local planning agencies, police and fire chiefs, and each of the 31 communities in Summit County; and

WHEREAS, following adoption by this Council, the ordinance adopting the updated Plan is forwarded to OEMA and FEMA; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve and adopt the aforementioned mitigation plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Council and Administration hereby approve and adopt the Summit County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
