BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

- The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, with Wichert Insurance Services, Inc., for the professional services necessary to manage the City's risk management and insurance program, including the purchase of comprehensive public entity insurance coverages, for a period of one year.
- The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from funds properly appropriated to the various departments of the City for these purposes, according to an apportionment of costs as between the departments.
- Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
- It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
- This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase public entity insurance coverages, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR, MEMBERS OF COUNCIL, COUNCIL PRESIDENT, AND CLERK OF COUNCIL COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2026 AND JANUARY 1, 2028 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council duly adopted Ordinance No. 109-1986 on May 27, 1986, amending Exhibits "C" and "D" of Ordinance No. 144-1985 and Exhibits "A" and "B" of Ordinance No. 84-1986 and Exhibits "C" and "D" of Ordinance No. 103-1986 establishing a schedule of pay ranges and steps for various jobs, offices and positions within the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Exhibit B of Ordinance No. 109-1986 the pay ranges of the office of council president and office of member of city council were set at sixteen percent (16%) and fifteen percent (15%) of the salary of the office of mayor respectively, and the pay range of the clerk of council was set at eighty percent (80%) of the salary of a council member; and

WHEREAS, the city council duly adopted Ordinance No. 79-1987 on April 27, 1987, amending Exhibits "A" and "B" of Ordinance No. 109-1986 and establishing a schedule of pay ranges and steps for various jobs, offices and positions within the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 79-1987, the pay range of the mayor was designated as "MSG" and pursuant to Section 2 of Ordinance No. 79-1987, the "positions classified as 'ESG' and 'MSG' shall have their midpoint adjusted annually at such time as a majority of the employees covered by bargaining agreements negotiated after January 1, 1987 shall have adopted contracts. Said adjustment of the midpoint shall be the weighted average of the annual wage adjustments received by bargaining units negotiated after January 1, 1987 but in no event to exceed the percentage of increase granted to other non-bargaining unit personnel. Said midpoint adjustment shall be retroactive to January 1 of each year. The Finance Director shall file with the Clerk of Council the new midpoints 30 days prior to implementation."

WHEREAS, at the November 4, 2025, general election the voters of Cuyahoga Falls will elect a mayor to a four (4) year term, eight (8) ward members of council to two (2) year terms, and two (2) of the members of council at large to four (4) year terms, and the winners of said general election will take office January 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, at the November 2, 2027, general election the voters of Cuyahoga Falls will elect a single at large member of council to four (4) year term along with eight (8) ward members of council to two (2) year terms, and the winners of said general election will take office January 1, 2028; and

 WHEREAS, council has deemed it advisable to set the compensation for the offices of mayor, council president, member of council, and clerk of council elected or appointed to future terms commencing January 1, 2026 and January 1, 2028, as applicable, and thereafter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That effective January 1, 2026, the annual salary for the office of mayor of the City of Cuyahoga Falls shall be the current salary for the office of mayor as of the effective date of this Ordinance, plus eleven percent (11%) of the salary for positions classified as "DSG" as of thirty (30) days prior to the date for the filing of nominating petitions for the primary election for the office of mayor. Said salary shall increase by two and one-half percent (2.5%) per year effective the following January 1 for the remainder of the mayor's four year term. Not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date for the filing of nominating petitions for the next primary election for the office of mayor, the annual salary for the office of mayor shall be adjusted as per the calculation set forth in this Ordinance, with the new salary effective the following January 1st at the commencement of the mayor's term of office, and the two and one-half percent (2.5%) annual increase effective thereafter.

Section 2. That effective January 1, 2026, the salary for the offices of the eight (8) ward members of council elected to a two (2) year term and the two (2) at large members of council elected to a four (4) year term at the November 4, 2025 general election shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the salary of the office of mayor as of January 1, 2026 as established per Section 1. The salaries for these offices shall increase by two and one-half percent (2.5%) per year effective following January 1 for the remainder of their two (2) and four (4) year terms. In the case of the offices of the eight (8) ward members of council elected to two (2) year terms in the years the mayor and the two (2) at large members of council are not on the ballot, their salaries, effective the January 1 after their election, shall be the salaries then in effect plus two and one-half percent (2.5%), and shall increase another two and one-half percent (2.5%) effective the following January 1 for the remainder of their two (2) year term. The salaries for the offices of the eight (8) ward members of council elected to a two (2) year term and the two (2) at large members of council elected to a two (2) year term shall be adjusted every four (4) years in accordance with the adjustment of the salary for the office of mayor as set forth in Section 1.

Section 3. That effective January 1, 2026, the salary for the office of council president shall be sixteen percent (16%) of the salary for the office of mayor. That salary shall increase by two and one-half (2.5%) per year effective the following January 1 for the remainder of the term of office and shall be adjusted every four (4) years in accordance with the adjustment of the salary for the office of mayor as set forth in Section 1.

Section 4. That effective January 1, 2026, the salary of the clerk of council shall be eighty percent (80%) of the salary of a member of council. The salary of the clerk of council shall increase by two and one-half percent (2.5%) effective the following January 1 and thereafter and shall be adjusted in accordance with the salary adjustments set forth in this Ordinance.

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Section 5. That effective January 1, 2028, the salary for the office of the single at large member of council elected to a four (4) year term at the November 2, 2027 general election shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the salary for the office of mayor then in effect. That salary shall increase by two and one-half percent (2.5%) per year for the remainder of the term of office and shall be adjusted every four (4) years in accordance with the adjustment of the salary for the office of mayor as set forth in Section 1.

<u>Section 6.</u> That it is the intent of this Ordinance that the mayor, members of council and council president not receive an increase in salary during their terms of office in which an increase was enacted.

<u>Section 7.</u> Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 8. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 9. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason of the increased cost of living and the necessity of keeping competent personnel within the City, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITIONS OF DIGITAL MEDIA SPECIALIST, GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM TECHNICIAN AND SAFETY AND TRAINING COMPLIANCE MANAGER: AMENDING EXHIBIT "A' OF ORDINANCE 41-2024; AND **ESTABLISHING** COMPENSATION LEVELS FOR NON-BARGAINING EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 79-1987, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 122-1993 IN CONNECTION WITH JOB CLASSIFICATIONS. POSITIONS AND COMPENSATION OF VARIOUS POSITIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 79-1987 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2. Positions classified as "ESG" and "MSG" "DSG" and "C/ESG" shall have their midpoint adjusted annually at such time as a majority of the employees covered by bargaining agreements negotiated after January 1, 2024 shall have adopted contracts. Said adjustment of the midpoint shall be weighted average of the annual wage adjustments received by said bargaining units negotiated after January 1, 2024 but in no event to exceed the percentage of increase granted to other non-bargaining unit personnel. Positions designated as "DSG" shall maintain a pay differential totaling seven percent of the top non-bargaining salary. Positions designated as "C/ESG" shall maintain a pay differential totaling five percent of the top non-bargaining salary. Said midpoint adjustment shall be retroactive to January 1 of each year. The Finance Director shall file with the Clerk of Council the new midpoints 30 days prior to implementation.

Section 2. Ordinance 122-1993 is hereby repealed. Further, any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
