 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO AMEND CONTRACT NO. 8762 WITH CTI ENGINEERS, INC., FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the existing softener building and ion exchange softening system at the Water Treatment Plant is 87 years old, obsolete, and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the current open-air brine treatment system is obsolete, open to the elements, and in need of replacement and updating; and

WHEREAS, optimizing the use of salt brine will minimize chloride discharge to the Cuyahoga River, which is regulated under the City's existing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit; and

WHEREAS, unforeseen obstacles in the project require an amendment to the existing contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 8762 with CTI Engineers, Inc. for the Water Treatment Plant improvements in an amount not to exceed \$760,000.00. The total contract price after modification as authorized herein shall not exceed \$1,350,000.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

 <u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH SUPERIOR DRAIN FOR EMERGENCY SANITARY SEWER REPAIR ASSISTANCE IN THE CITY RIGHT OF WAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Superior Drain was the only available contractor able to assist in emergency sanitary sewer repairs; and

WHEREAS, although no specific expenditure for repairs in the City right of way has individually exceeded the threshold competitive bidding amount to date, collectively the expenditures may soon exceed the competitive bidding amount of \$75,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Superior Drain for emergency sanitary sewer repair assistance in the City right of way in a total amount not to exceed \$105,000.00 for the 2024 fiscal year.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Sewage and Disposal Fund, line items Capital Outlay and Other Operations.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

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AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF MONEY FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES, CAPITAL EXPENDITURES AND OTHER EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2025, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5705.38 requires local taxing authorities to pass an annual appropriations measure classified so as to set forth the amounts appropriated to each office, department and division of the taxing authority; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 6 of the City Charter requires the Mayor to submit an estimated budget for the coming fiscal year showing the requested allotments of the appropriations and estimated income for each office or department for the calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> In order to provide for the current expenses, capital expenditures, and other expenses of the City of Cuyahoga Falls for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025, the sums summarized in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto incorporated herein by reference, are hereby appropriated and authorized for encumbrance and/or expenditure as provided therein.

<u>Section 2.</u> The fund transfers and advances set forth in detail in Exhibit A2, and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby authorized and approved.

Section 3. The budget for each office and department of the City is hereby determined and approved as set forth in Exhibit B, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and the expenditures authorized therein, and the amount authorized, shall be made in accordance with the line items identified in Exhibit B, and any disbursements within any line item set forth in Exhibit B may be paid out of the appropriations made therefor.

<u>Section 4.</u> No transfers of sums shall be made between departments. Transfers of sums from one line item listed in Exhibit B to another line item, within the same department, at any time within the fiscal year which exceed in the aggregate seven percent (7%) of the amount originally appropriated in the line item from which the transfer is made, or \$10,000.00, whichever is less, shall be prohibited unless authorized by ordinance or resolution of Council.

<u>Section 5.</u> Any amounts encumbered in a fiscal year prior to fiscal year 2025 in any and all funds of the City, are hereby re-appropriated for the purpose of expenditure in 2025 or thereafter.

<u>Section 6.</u> All funds not individually listed in this ordinance but included in the 2025 Alternative Tax Budget Information of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and included in the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for 2025 as issued by the County of Summit Budget Commission are hereby appropriated for the purpose of encumbrance

and/or expenditure.

<u>Section 7.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 8.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 9. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that authority is required for the payment of operations, other and capital expenses of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
