7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-1987
8 ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES WITHIN THE
9 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS,
10 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State
13 of Ohio, that:

15 Section 1. Ordinance 82-1987, Section 3, shall be amended as follows:

16
17 Section 2. Advancement or Change in pay Ranges or Steps. Employees advancing from range
18 to range shall be placed in the range **step commensurate in** which provides the employee
19 ~~compensation closest to a five percent increase but not more than seven percent in excess of that~~
20 ~~which~~ the employee was receiving in the position from which he had advanced unless the Articles
21 of Agreement entered into by the City with certain employee organizations provide otherwise
22 concerning "working assignments."

24 Section 3. Any ordinances and resolutions, or portions of ordinances and resolutions
25 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
26 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
27

28 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
30 that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal
31 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements to the
32 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


34 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
35 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
36 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of
37 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately
38 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
39 earliest period allowed by law.
