8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE, AND
9 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and maintained
12 in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the Chief of Police
13 pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances; and
14

15 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic Control
16 File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.
17

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
19 of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
20

21 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is
22 hereby amended as follows:
23

24 Amending the Traffic Control File by prohibiting parking on the South Side of Ashland
25 Avenue, from Hudson Drive to 644 Ashland Avenue.
26

27 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to note in the Traffic Control File the proper
28 legends.
29

30 Section 3. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to cause the installation or
31 removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.


33 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
34 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
35 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously
36 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
37

38 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
39 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
40 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
41 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the
42 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
43

44 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
45 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
46 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
47 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon
48 its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
49 period allowed by law.
