The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with Medical 18 Mutual Services, LLC, for the professional services necessary to conduct the administration of the 19 City's self-insured employee medical plans for a period not to exceed one year. 20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay approved invoices for work based 21 22 upon the Contract, from the Self-Insurance Fund, line item Other Operations. 23 24 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions 25 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed. 26 27 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and 28 29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that 30 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, 31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent 32 applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances. 33 34 Section 5.
