The Cuyahoga Falls Parks and Recreation Department has several outdoor shelters for your picnicking pleasure. The rate for all shelters is \$45/day for Cuyahoga Falls residents, \$55/day for nonresidents. Shelters are only reserved by the day, from sunrise to sunset (approx 6 am-9 pm).

Reservation Policy

Cuyahoga Falls residents may make reservations one (1) year to the date in advance (online, in person, or over the phone). Nonresidents may make reservations 6 months to the date in advance (in person or over the phone only; online option not provided at this time). No more than two (2) reservations may be on the calendar for each household/organization. To register call the Parks and Recreation main office at 330-971-8225, Quirk Cultural Center at 330-971-8425, or go online. Payment is due at time of reservation by cash, check (in person) or Visa, MasterCard, or Discover if over the phone or online. To use the RecPerks! card discount, reservation must be made in person at the Quirk Cultural Center or Parks and Recreation main office, otherwise full price will be charged.

<u>Cornhole</u>: use of the permanent, cement cornhole game(s) at applicable shelters are reserved for permit holders only. If shelter is not reserved & no permit holder is present, cornhole becomes first come, first served until a permit holder is present. NOTE: Bean bags are NOT provided.

Refund Policy

Reservations cancelled 6 months or more prior to the reservation date receive a 90% refund; less than 6 months notice receives a 50% refund.

Alcoholic Beverages

No person will bring into, keep, carry, serve, or drink any beverage containing alcohol inside or outside the premises.
